**Mobile Text Messages:** A letter has been emailed to all parents of Woodstock Christian School. The letter explains how to join the REMIND system, the same system that was well received last year. It is an efficient means of one-way communication to parents in the event of bus delays or cancellations or other unusual events. Please look for the email and follow the steps to receive text messages delivered directly to your mobile phone. Please note that notices will continue to be posted on the website.

**Foster Child:** Last year we began to support a new child from Mission to Haiti. Djinylove just turned 4 on Aug. 29th. We are very excited to be continuing to collect money to support her this year. Collections will take place Fridays and any amount is appreciated.

**Leadership Teams:** At an assembly next week, students will be introduced to WCS LEADERSHIP TEAMS. Each student is asked to prayerfully fill out a questionnaire which helps them uncover/share their leadership qualities and strengths. They are also asked which team(s) they would like to participate in based on the gifts God has given them to serve the school community while developing new personal skills. Growing in becoming Christian servers, students discover God's ultimate truth, their unique gifts, and their purpose in life. At WCS we offer over twenty leadership teams ranging from technology to morning announcement teams. These leadership teams also act as enrichment vehicles for every student in our school, giving them the opportunity to lead and excel beyond the scope of academics and their classroom responsibilities. Parents please discuss these opportunities with your child(ren) and help them fill out their questionnaires.

**Phys Ed Kit:** Students in grades 5 and up will be required to wear proper clothing for their physical education classes beginning this week. The kit consists of a WCS t-shirt and gray shorts (those purchased in previous years are allowed). The uniform is available in the school office at a cost of \$20.00/set. Please make sure that your child's name or initials are placed in the shirt and shorts since there will be many similar outfits in the school. Students should keep their phys ed kit in their backpack.

**Early Dismissal Days:** As you receive the September paperwork from the WCS office, and as you read through the calendar, you will notice that there are three (3) Early Dismissal days listed. On these days, our end-of-day buses will run early and students will leave WCS at 1:30 pm. (These are not school days for LDCSS students, so they will not be affected.) Teachers will stay at school and work in their Professional Learning Communities (PLCs). These afternoons are set aside for teachers to go deeper with some of the learning initiatives that we have started at WCS, such as differentiated instruction, project-based learning, application of growth mindset strategies and more. These blocks of time allow for more focussed application and planning for our staff and are intended to enhance the learning environment in the classroom. The dates for these are September 30<sup>th</sup>, December 9<sup>th</sup>, and January 27<sup>th</sup>. There will be more information as each of these dates approaches.

**From the Library:** A warm welcome from the WCS Library. We are geared up once again to give the students great reading material and community in our library. Library officially begins next week for all students. Along with the regular book exchanges there will also be opportunities for students to use and enjoy the library. Students will be notified about these opportunities regularly through the announcements they listen to in the morning. **Milk Bags:** We are continuing to collect milk bags this year. Please send your clean outer milk bags to the Grade 1 classroom and we will be turn these into mats to send to those who are in need. Questions - please don't hesitate to ask Mrs. Schuster.

**Woodstock Christian School and the Buses are NUT FREE (not just peanut-free)!** We have students enrolled who have allergies to more than just peanuts, so we need to be a NUT FREE FACILITY for the safety of all students here at WCS! Please make sure that when you are packing lunches, treating our staff with goodies (which we love and so appreciate by the way!), or sending birthday treats, no nuts of any kind are included.

**Cancellations: For FOG DAYS,** when driving conditions are too dangerous for the buses to run, our WCS school buses will be cancelled. It is expected that parents will drive their children into WCS when they feel that it is safe to do so. All classes will

begin at normal time (8:25 am). The busses will run as usual after school to bring the students home. For students traveling to LDCSS, you can expect there to be a bus that will leave WCS at 8:10 (or when that bus driver believes that it is safe to drive to London). Please bring your high-school students to WCS for 8:10, providing you believe the roads are safe. The London bus will drive students home (as usual) at the end of the school day. For bad weather such as SNOW or ICE DAYS, school will be cancelled, and classes will not run for the day. Please sign up for the REMIND instant messaging system. You may also consult the school's web site at [www.woodstockchristian.ca](http://www.woodstockchristian.ca) to see if buses are running. See elsewhere in the Parent Link about signing up for REMIND to receive notices via texts on your cell phone.

**Dress Code:** Please make sure that your children have two pairs of shoes at school. One pair is to be worn outdoors and one pair is for indoor use. Students must wear shoes at all times to avoid injury or infection. Our students must always wear socks and so flip flops are not acceptable footwear at WCS. Please note: all tops worn by our students in grades four and up must have sleeves and must comfortably reach the top of the pants, trousers, shorts, skirt, etc.

**Morning Arrival of Students:** When the students arrive at school in the morning they should immediately proceed to the play areas until it is time to enter the building at 8:20. Only kindergarten (junior and senior) students and SON Beams are allowed to enter the school before this time. Parents who bring their children to school are asked to bring them to the front entrance of the school to avoid our buses all together; we feel this will be safer for all students. Students dropped off at the front of the school may enter the school and then head right outside to the playground. When the weather is too wet for the students to be outside they are all welcome to enter the school as soon as they arrive, using their normal entrances from the playground.

**Departure:** At the end of the day, parents who are picking up their children must enter the school and check with the teacher on duty before children are released.

**Transportation:**

- Students need to be at their stops 8-10 minutes early for the first week. There will be some flex in the pick up times given as drivers get to know their routes. Once we are up and running, students should be at their stops 5 minutes early.
- Communicate with your route captain if you have questions or need clarification. Concerns for the transportation committee must be made in writing and will be dealt with at their September meeting.
- Routes will run as is for the first two weeks. We expect there to be some changes as some families are moving and as we get the bumps out of the system. Your patience is much appreciated!
- Your bus drivers are terrific people who are trying to do difficult jobs. Please do your best to work with them and the rules and procedures that they have set up on the bus. Good, clear communication is really important between bus drivers and bus riders to ensure a safe, enjoyable year on the bus. Thanks!
- We do not yet have a spare bus - but it's coming! For the interim, when we have a breakdown, a route may be cancelled. Please bear with us - and thanks for your cooperation.
- We need bus drivers! If you would like to drive or know someone who would be interested in driving or training to drive, please contact the office asap.

**Head Lice Checks at WCS:** This week, we will conduct our annual Head Lice Check for all the students from JK to 8. If your child is found to have either the live bugs or nits, you will be contacted by phone. We appreciate your taking prompt action to get rid of these pests. Though lice are a nuisance, they do not transmit disease. They are not in any way related to the cleanliness of your child or your home. Anyone can become infested with them! We do want to get rid of them as quickly as possible, and we want to avoid other children from getting them. We ask you all to help. Head lice is transmitted mainly through head to head contact. They can also be transmitted through sharing of combs and hats. If your child is persistently itching his/her head, particularly around the ears, he/she may have head lice. You can also detect head lice by examining the head for nits. If you don't know what to look for, yet suspect your child may have head lice, please contact the school, your doctor or your pharmacist and someone will check your child's head. There are many different types of treatments your pharmacist can assist you in choosing the best one. Because the nits are encased in a hard, cement-like substance, it is very possible that not all of them will be killed in the first application. It is recommended that a second treatment be applied 7-10 days later to kill any newly hatched nymphs. You may also choose to treat your child's head with a natural substance- tea tree oil and Molkosan. Visit a Health Supplement Store, and they will help you select the best treatment for your child. They also have a formula you can use on your children to prevent head lice. Here at JKCS we have information for both treatments - the pharmaceutical treatment and the natural substance treatment. Call the office for information.

**Welcome Dessert Social:** Another school year is beginning! We are celebrating the return to another school year with our Welcome Dessert Social planned for Friday, September 15, 2017. We will begin the evening with classroom visits 6:30-7:15 pm. A time of prayer in the classrooms will follow at 7:25 pm. Dessert will be served at 7:30 pm. Each WCS family is asked to bring

a dessert to share, PEANUT/NUT FREE. We are also looking for help in the kitchen at 6:00 to prep desserts and set up in the gym and after the evening is completed to clean up, both in the kitchen and putting away chairs and tables in the gym. **Grade 5:** Welcome back to school! I hope you've all enjoyed the summer months (I know I have). I have been looking forward to this school year, and I pray that your child has a great year at WCS. Please read this Parent-Link paragraph each week. We have a field trip on Thursday September 8th already! Please contact me if you'd like to come. The more

We'll be heading to Caren and Willem Duizer's farm at about 1 pm on Thursday to learn about modern farming practices. This links well with our social studies unit which is all about ancient farming communities. We'll eventually compare and contrast ancient farming practices to current farming. We'll return to WCS at 3:20 or so for students to catch the bus home.

There will be many papers coming home this week. Please read through each one, and sign-off on each so that all the paper work is in order for your child right away.

We also have a neat service learning project which will run the course of the entire school year: We'll be learning about poverty in Haiti and specifically how we can help out Lagosette Christian School. Already in the first week students will learn about Haiti and Lagosette, and begin brainstorming ways in which we can help them out by fundraising or collecting books and supplies for them.

Regarding the agenda/day planner system: At the end of each school day, I will check to see that they've written down their homework tasks in their agenda. They will be excused if they did indeed write their homework down and have their homework in their hands. I ask that your child approaches you each evening after his/her homework is finished to get their agenda signed by you, signifying that you have checked to see that the homework is finished. I will look for that signature in the morning. If your child receives a signature for each day of the week, he/she will be rewarded with a piece of candy/chocolate! My goals for this system are to foster planning/organizational skills and provide another form of communication between myself and you with regards to homework. Typically, I don't assign a lot of homework, but each Friday memory work is due, and there is a spelling test and a spelling lesson due. Sometimes an additional quiz as well. This means students need to be studying for quizzes throughout the week so that they aren't waiting until Thursday evening. If there is a large unit test or project due date coming up, you will be informed through this parent link or in a separate email.
